**Maths:** This week's learning objective is: **read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12- and 24-hour clocks.**

Mondays activity: See the attached Power point and work through the questions.

Continue to practice your times tables every day!

As an extra challenge can you create your own matching pairs game? Write the time in words on one piece of paper and the digital time on another piece of paper, repeat so that you have between 6 and 10 pairs (depending on how long you want the game to last!), shuffle and place face down, take it in turns to pick up 2 cards – if they match keep them, whoever has the most pairs at the end is the winner!

**English:** This week we will be all about poetry! The learning objectives are:

**Identify and comment on the use of similes and expressive language to create images, sound effects and atmosphere**

**Write an independent example of free verse.**

Continue to read a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts and practise any spellings on the Year3/4 list that you are unsure of.
