Home Learning – Year - Week beginning 23/3/20

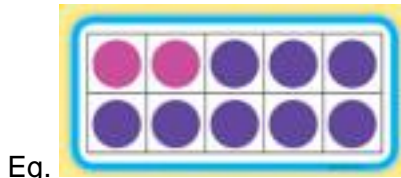
Maths:

Number: This week in Maths We Are Learning To (WALT): find pairs of numbers which make 10.

This week our Maths activities are going to be focusing on **number bonds to 10**. The class have consolidated their learning of bonds to 5 and have spent a little time last term touching on bonds to 10. We are aiming for children to learn the pairs to 10 and use it in their everyday activities.

For the **focus activity** this week, children are to explore making ten on the 10-frame below. The children can use practical resources to support their learning; how about finding two different types or different coloured objects? This could also be done by making a large 10 frame on the floor using tape or similar to mark out and then fill in with larger items. Move on to record these as number sentences using the $___ + ___ = ___$ format. (in red exercise book or on the sheet provided on the website)

Key Questions: *How many ways can we make 10? What are the pairs of numbers which make 10?*



$$1 + 9 = 10$$

$$2 + 8 = 10$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$

Developing Further: Can your child find the missing number when you give them a partially completed bond to 10, number sentence?

For example, finding the missing number : $______ + ___3___ = 10$
