Phonics: Phase 3

<https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-ksblMiliA8> This video shows the correct pronunciation of each sound and the way the mouth moves as we say the sound. It is a slightly old video and a bit tedious but the sounds are spot on so give this a watch to be sure you're teaching the correct sound. It's so important for blending that you don't add an 'uh' sound on to the sounds. For example; for *m* we say "mmmmmm" not "muh".

Look at the phonics phase 2 & 3 and Tricky Word powerpoint. As the children are shown each sound, they say it aloud. If you don't have access to the powerpoint, you could point at each of the sounds from your phase 3 and tricky word word-mat and your child say each sound aloud in turn.

Show your child the 'ar' sound. Can they think of any words with the *ar* sound in? Write these down for them as they say each one, encouraging your children to sound out each word to help you spell it. Some examples are: *car, bark, card, cart, hard, jar, park, market, farmyard*.

Say the following caption out loud and ask your child to write it as you do, encouraging them to sound out the words and try to be independent:

The car is red.
