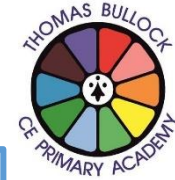

Home Learning: Year 3 – Thursday 26th March



Please try to read a little every single day! If you can write something each day too that will help to maintain your super writing!

The Body Coach is doing daily exercises on YouTube at 9am if you want to keep active!

Spellings for week:

guard, guide, heard, heart, height, history, imagine, increase, important and interest.

English: This week the children are learning about free verse poetry.

Today the children can write their poem!

They need to use their plan to turn their ideas into a poem, using the features they looked at on Tuesday (Alliteration, repetition, rhythm, onomatopoeia). They could write more than one version and decide which has a better rhythm and flows the best. This is their final version, ready for tomorrow's task!

Maths: We are continuing our work on Fractions this week.

Today we are ordering and comparing fractions. There is a PowerPoint to go through with lots of examples to support your learning. Slide 16 onwards has plenty of questions to answer in your red books.

If you want further work, in the class folder, there is a maths pdf file which has 3 levels of challenge again (one star up to 3 stars). If you are unable to print, it will probably be easiest if the children draw the shapes and fractions and then colour the correct amounts.

Music:

On a Thursday, the class usually has PE and Music. I will apologise now to the adults at home today...but on Purple Mash I have found a really fun (and noisy) tool (I have assigned it in the '2dos'), where the children can create their own simple melodies using different instrument sounds. They can then speed up or slow down the melodies.

If they want to develop this further under 'Tools' → 'Music and sound' there are more musical sequencing games to play.
