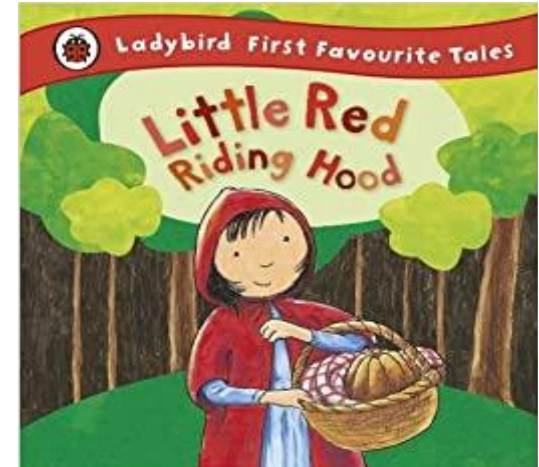
Home Learning – Year R - Week beginning 27/4/2020

Literacy:

1. Watch the story of Little Red Riding Hood here: <https://vimeo.com/411818836>
2. Write a list of things that Little Red Riding Hood might have in her basket to take to Granny's house when Mum asked her to. Can you write a sentence for each thing to say why she might take it? For example, she might take Granny some flowers to make her feel happy or she might take her some medicine to make her sore head feel better.
3. Write a letter to Granny. At the start of the story, Little Red Riding Hood is taking the basket of goodies because Granny is feeling poorly. Pretend you are Little Red Riding Hood. Could you write her a 'Get Well Soon Letter'. Maybe you could tell her what you have been up to and include a couple of things she could do, to help her feel better. Your letter could be from the end of the story and could be a letter to thank Granny (or the huntsman) for a yummy tea.



Maths:

We are learning to subtract using the counting back method, using numbers within 10. Have a look at this video lesson here to help you: <https://vimeo.com/411818895>

Don't forget to use a number jump to count careful jumps backwards!

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Phonics:

We're continuing to reinforce our learning of phase 3 sounds and tricky words, with a focus on digraphs (2 letters making one sound) and trigraphs (3 letters making one sound).

This week, please look on the BBC phonics website here <https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zvq9bdm> and scroll down to find the trigraphs (one for each day of the week); *igh*, *ear*, *air*, *ure* and the digraph *oa*. You will have a short video to watch each day followed by some quick fire learning tasks.

Remember to keep practising your rapid recall of all sounds using your flashcards and also the tricky words.

Let your child read these sentences independently and ask them to answer with a yes or no to show their understanding:

- Can a bus go down a road?
- Will you meet a shark at the park?
- Can a clock get cross?
- Can crabs clap hands?
- Is the moon green?
- Can you bang on a big drum?
