Our theme over the holiday is:



Make a wild crown! Make a crown from things you collect in the garden or on a walk and wear it all day — don't forget to send a photo!

Make friends with a bug — ladybirds, woodlice & spiders. There are all kinds of creepy crawlies hiding in your garden. Watch what they do. Don't pick them up or handle them they are very delicate. Try making somewhere for them to live —

Grow a plant — you definitely can't do this in a day or two but you can plant a seed at the start of the holiday and see how much it grows by the end.

Keep a nature Diary — Spring is a time when things change a lot. Note down and draw any changes in plants.
