Today's word of the day is **luminosity**.

Look it up in a dictionary or online, or ask someone in your house what it means. Find the word class, definition, synonyms, antonyms and use it in a sentence. Why not post your sentence on the class blog? Now you know what it means, can you draw or paint a picture of a scene or object which comes into your head when you hear the word?

English – vocabulary focus

Today's lesson is all about learning the key vocabulary for our science topic. **Start** with the file 'Monday English activity 1'. Make sure you can spell each word, as well as knowing its meaning. **Now** have a look at 'Monday English activity 2' and work out which of these scientific adjectives would fill in each of my blank spaces. You can copy it into your book if you wish. As **a final activity**, I would like you to write your own 'fill in the blanks' paragraph, leaving spaces for each of today's words, and post it on the blog for everyone else to see and try out. You can write about anything at all, as long as it uses each of today's words correctly.

This week's **spelling activities** are all on one file, 'Spelling activities for this week'. They focus on spelling and vocabulary building. Just do **ONE PAGE each day** – the answers are given at the end. If you can print, then do if you would like to, but you don't have to – you can answer all the questions in your exercise book instead.
