Use your boxed-up plan from yesterday and remember to include:

- Roman names and animals
- A Roman setting using vocabulary we have gathered
- Noun phrases
- Fronted adverbials
- Paragraphs (each box in your plan could be a paragraph)

Read the sections below as you write them to help you include everything! You can change it and use your creativity too.

Section 1:

Introduce your main character and show the reader the MC is poor.

Give a bit of detail about your MC's daily life by using a fronted adverbial like "Every day..." or "During her working hours..." or "Each week..."

Section 2:

Introduce the animal who is helped in some way by the MC. Describe this new character in detail (noun phrases would come in handy here!)

Section 3:

In this section grant the main character a wish.

Section 4:

Make sure your main character thinks about what his / her family and friends need.

Section 5

Have your main character return to the wish granting creature. You might combine the needs of your MC's friends or family into one wish. You could use fronted adverbials like "Immediately" or "Suddenly"
