### **Spellings for week:**

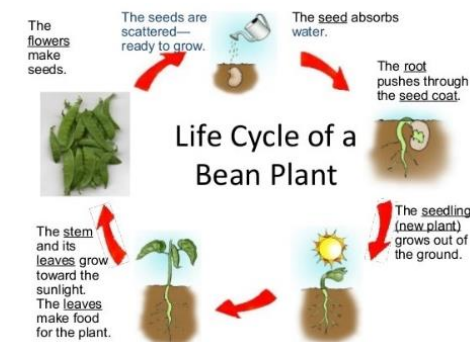
Naughty, notice, occasion, often, opposite, ordinary, particular, peculiar, perhaps, popular
