Spelling This half term I have set up an account for you all on Oxford Owl, which gives us access to activities for Read, Write Inc. Go to www.oxfordowl.co.uk and click the pink 'My Class Login' at the top. The username is mrs lindner and the password is North America. This will take you to a page where you then select Read Write Inc Extra Practice Zone. Click this and navigate to activities for 9-11yrs (or other ages if you need extra practice). Choose whichever activity you like and work on it for about 15 mins.
