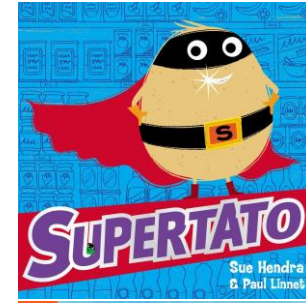

Literacy:

For our Literacy lessons this week, we are going to make a wanted poster for the 'Evil Pea!' The Evil-pea escaped from the freezer and we need to find him...draw a picture and write a description underneath in full sentences before explaining *why* the Evil-pea needs to be caught (before he hurts any other children!) Don't forget to think about a reward for his capture! Don't forget that lots of talk is very important before you write! Discuss the picture, say the sentence aloud a few times and then put your ideas on paper. Try very hard to form your letters correctly (starting and finishing in the right place), sitting your letters neatly on the lines, sounding out for your spellings, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!

Maths:
