L. O. to identify the different parts of the digestive system and describe their functions

Listed below are some suggested activities that you could have a go at. You are not expected to do all of them and if you have other ideas feel free to do them instead or as well!

- First of all, if you are not sure what the word digestion means look it up in a dictionary or online.
- Then before watching the videos draw an outline of a human body and add in any organs that you think are involved in the process of digestion - if you have a large enough piece of paper you could draw around someone in your house! (Keep your drawing somewhere safe as you will need it again next week!)
- Now you can watch the videos! How many of the organs involved could you name? Did you put them in the right place?
