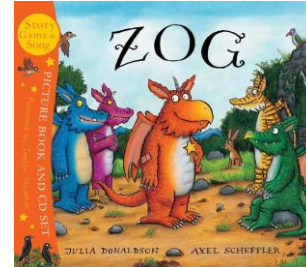

Literacy:

For our Literacy lessons this week, we are going to work on writing creatively in full sentences. Use the creative writing prompts and think of some sentences to write down. Don't forget that lots of talk is very important before you write! Discuss the picture, say the sentence aloud a few times and then put your ideas on paper. Try very hard to form your letters correctly (starting and finishing in the right place), sitting your letters neatly on the lines, sounding out for your spellings, using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops!

Handwriting: as the children move on into year 1, they will be introduced to pre-cursive and cursive (joined up) handwriting. Around this time in reception, we usually start to introduce the pre-cursive - whooshes on the letters! I've included a hand writing practise booklet this week...take your time and don't rush to complete it all at once.

Maths:
