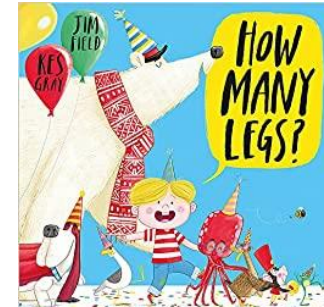
Literacy:
