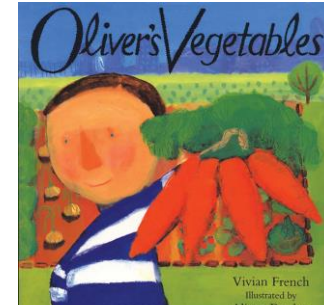

- Look at the writing stimulus picture. Write some sentences about what you can see. Can you add some adjectives to describe?
- Write a book review. What do you like or not like about the story? Can you give reasons for your choices by using the word 'because'?
