

Dear Parents and Carers,

Monday 7th September 2020

Ref: Day 1 observations

8:40a.m.: Bubble 3 Year 3 Africa Class– **this Bubble finishes at 3:15pm**

8:45a.m.: Bubble 2 Year 2 Asia Class– **this Bubble finishes at 3:10pm**

8:50a.m.: Bubble 1 Year 1 Oceania– **this Bubble finishes at 3:10pm**

8:55a.m.: Bubble R EYFS Ark Class– **this Bubble finishes at 3:05pm (from Sept 14)**

Staff in all year groups will be outside tomorrow morning to support the fast entry into school.

It is imperative that you adhere to this timetable. Please do not turn up early as this leads to gatherings and crowding – which is exactly what we are trying to avoid. Please also ensure that you leave immediately after drop off, we will remind you not to hang around tomorrow.

From tomorrow you will notice flags with your year group numbers, on the roundabout, at the front of the school gates. Please line up behind these numbers relating to your child's year group. The teacher will line-up at these numbers to guide your line, we request you leave when your teacher arrives. Please once again stick to the staggered timings.

Please note we will take your child's temperature inside of the classroom in order to ensure a speedy process. However, if your child has a temperature you will be notified.

Collections

KS1 parents please wait behind the numbered arrow for your child's year group to arrive for collection.

KS2 will arrive from the KS2 playground gate at 3:15 and 3:20pm. Please line-up behind the year-group arrow flags, socially distanced, and await your child to arrive from the school gates.

Car park and Playschool:
