


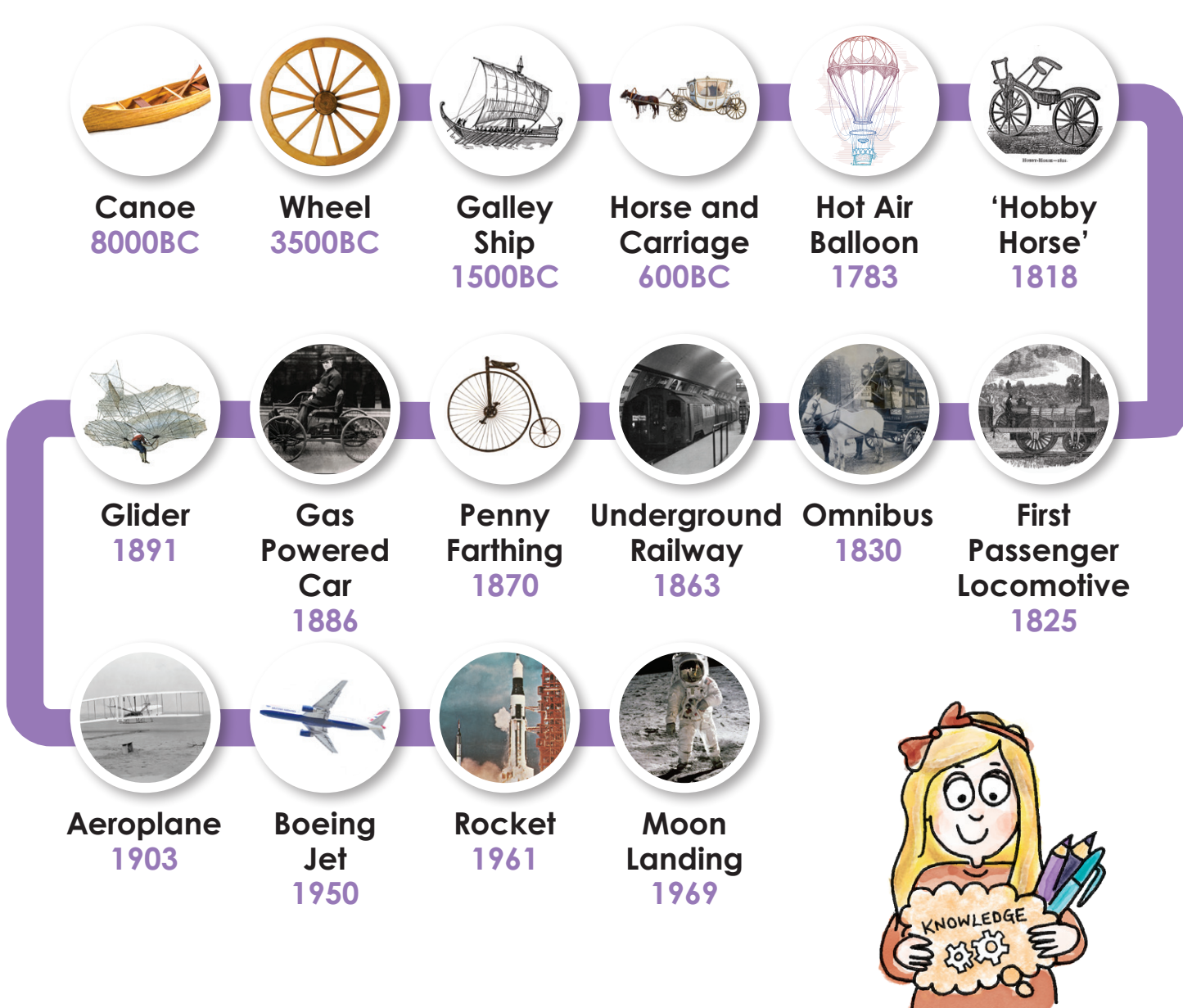








Key Words
