

Our Learning Objectives: child's belongings!

Our focus texts this term will be:







We will be looking at adventure stories, poetry, instructions, speech and non-fiction fact texts.

In Maths we will be deepening our understanding of numbers to 10 and exploring numbers beyond. We will learn about numerical patterns, odds and evens, halves and doubles.

In Read, Write Inc. phonics we will be consolidating our learning so far of previously taught sounds. We'll complete set 2 sounds and focus on 'holding a sentence' when writing. We will continue on Red ditty & green storybooks before extending further.

This half term's learning:

Our topic this term is 'How does it grow?'

We will be focusing our learning around the topic of GROWTH & SPRING.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Taking responsibility.

Understanding the World/Expressive Arts & Design/:
