



### Headline facts and figures

**These are the first key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019, after assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic**

These statistics cover the attainment of year 6 pupils who took assessments in summer 2022. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 4 and in year 5.

#### **Attainment in all of reading, writing and maths has decreased compared to 2019**

Nationally, 59% of pupils met the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, down from 65% in 2019.

*At Thomas Bullock, 88.3% of pupils met the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, which is above 2019 58% and 23.3% above National this year.*

*We predicted 86.6% but one child achieved a 99 standardised score dropping one mark in reading.*

*In 2017- 48% achieved RWM, in 2018- 44% achieved RWM combined and in 2019- 58% achieved RWM*

#### **In individual subjects, attainment increased slightly in reading and fell in all other subjects compared to 2019**

Nationally, 74% of pupils met the expected standard in reading, up from 73% in 2019.

*In our school, 86.7% of pupils met the expected standard in reading, up from 69% in 2019.*

Nationally, 71% of pupils met the expected standard in maths, down from 79% in 2019.

*In our school, 90% of pupils met the expected standard in maths, which is significantly up from 69% in 2019.*

Nationally, 69% of pupils met the expected standard in writing, down from 78% in 2019.

*In our school, 86.6% of pupils met the expected standard in writing, up from 85% in 2019. Our 93.3% in GPS shows that this is secure and we were moderated in KS1 and Phonics.*

Nationally, 72% of pupils met the expected standard in grammar, punctuation and spelling, down from 78% in 2019.

*In our school, 93.3% of pupils met the expected standard in GPS. This is well above national average.*

Nationally, 79% of pupils met the expected standard in science, down from 83% in 2019.

*In our school, 90% of pupils met the expected standard in Science.*

*This is 7% above the national average.*
