This Half Term's Learning

This half term our topic focus is History. We will be taking a learning journey about Roman Invasions



English Learning Objectives

This half term we will be reading the books <u>We were Romans</u> and <u>Escape from Pompeii</u>.

Initially, we will be exploring the structures of non—chronological reports based on the lives of Romans. We will be looking closely at the History of Romans; what they enjoy, they ate and what they wore. We will be looking closely at the importance of fact, third person and presentational features of non-chronological reports.

Following this we will begin looking at recounts in the form of letters and Newspaper reports focusing on the class book, **Escape from Pompeii**. We will look closely at the structures and language features of these text types; and use these skills to create interesting letters from characters in our story and newspaper articles of events from our class book.

Reading Stars will continue each morning to develop the children's reading and comprehension skills as well as Grammar Gurus to support us with our grammar skills.

Maths Learning Objectives

We will start the half term by looking at **place value**. We will be recapping numbers to 1000 before looking at rounding to the nearest 10 and 100, comparing 4-digit numbers and looking at negative numbers alongside some roman numerals.

We will then move onto **addition and subtraction.** We will be working with three digit and four-digit numbers. We will be looking at different methods to complete these addition and subtraction calculations.

Lastly, we will look closely at **money.** We will look at the value of pounds and pence, converting between, giving change as well as adding and subtracting money.

Other curriculum areas:

In **Science** we will be learning about teeth and digestion. We will be identifying the different types of teeth and understanding their uses, learning how to keep our teeth healthy and how this varies in different animals, as well as looking at what makes up our digestive system and how it works.

In **History** we will be learning about who the Romans were and the different people who contributed to the invasions across Britain, those who fought to protect against invasion of Britain and the fall of Roman Britain.

In **Art** we will be exploring shape, pattern and texture and how we can effectively use these skills to create mosaics inspired by our chosen artist, Antoni Gaudi.

In RE we will be learning about where Christians beliefs come from.

We will start off **Computing** looking closely at the importance of E-Safety, arming ourselves with the support and understanding of how to keep safe online.

In PSHE we will be looking at our skills, strengths and interests as individuals.

Music will be led by our wonderful music hub and **P.E.** from Mrs Greenland.
