Should you have any queries or concerns at any time, please do get in touch with Mrs Marjoram in the first instance, via the main school office or at the end of the day.


### This half term's learning:




We will be learning about celebrations and the change in seasons during our theme entitled 'Winter Wonderland'.

We will also be learning about Diwali, Guy Fawkes/Bonfire night, Remembrance Sunday, Thanksgiving as well as the Nativity story and writing our own Christmas letters to post to the North Pole.

#### Our Learning Focuses:







As well as practising writing our name, we'll be story mapping; retelling the story; describing the characters; sequencing; looking at rhymes (and making Gruffalo Crumble!) We'll be using our phonics all the time, as we start to read and write words, captions and labels!

In phonics, we'll be continuing with our set I RWI sounds and word time sessions. Children will soon be learning our first special friends (diagraphs—two letters making one sound eg. ch, sh, th, nk)

We will have our first trip in a couple of weeks! In Maths we start our learning in the phase of 'It's me...I, 2, 3!' where we will identify, compare and construct these numbers at a greater depth.

We will explore 'why do Christians perform in Nativity plays at Christmas?' during our RE sessions.

### Things to remember:

Please, please, please make sure you name EVERY ITEM that belongs to your child. If these items are not named, we cannot get them back to you!

Remember to interact with **Tapestry**. You can see what we get up to and we'd love you to add some things from home too.
