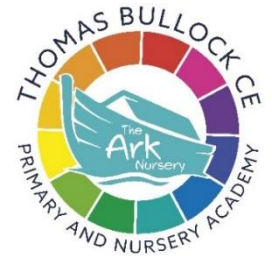


The Ark Nursery Newsletter
