This week's sound has been 's'. We looked at different objects beginning with the sound 's', created the letter s with spaghetti and had a go at writing one too, repeating our RWI phrase "Slither down the snake". In Literacy, we were introduced to our story of 'Mrs Armitage on Wheels' and began story mapping this together. During our afternoons together, we learnt all about different types of transport, watched videos and sorted modes of transport into categories such as: on water, on a road, on a track, in the sky. We created train pictures with a range of shapes, naming them as we stuck them down!

- Squares and rectangles are shapes that have 4 straight sides. Can you spot anything square or rectangle shaped in your home? Have a go at drawing some to make a robot!
