
The Ark Nursery Newsletter

Next week

Next weeks theme is pirates! Arrrr! Our focus book for the week will be 'Ten Little Pirates'. During our maths sessions, we will explore capacity. Our new sounds in RWI Phonics are 'u' and 'b'. We will continue our afternoon learning surrounding Easter, being introduced to the religion Christianity. We will learn about what it means to be a Christian, explore churches and what we find inside them. This is in readiness for our Easter service at Shipdham Church. We will also continue looking at the world — exploring people from different countries, holidays we might have been on or places / climates we might like to visit!

Learning links at home

- At bath time, use lots of different empty containers. Use different sizes, like bowls or stacking cups. Explore directly pouring from one container into the other and describe what happens to them "Oh no! That one overflowed!" or "There is still lots of space left in that one it is only half full!"
- Bake a cake using a recipe that measures out the ingredients in 'cups'. Let your child measure out the ingredients. Talk about when the cups are full, nearly full or half full. Help them count the cups as they pour them into a large bowl to mix the ingredients together.
