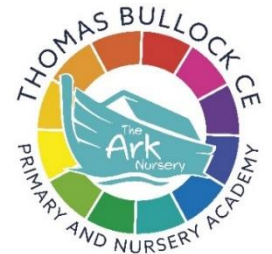


# The Ark Nursery Newsletter
