

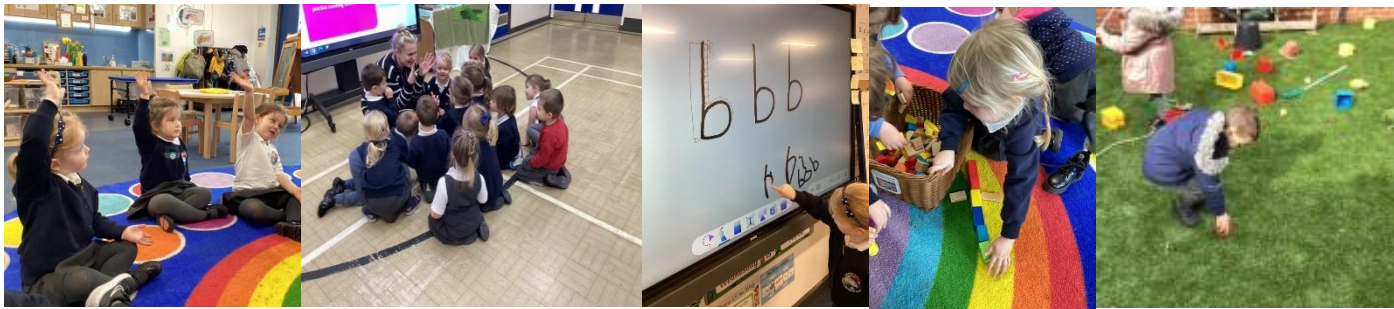
The Ark Nursery Newsletter

We have been practising saying and writing our new sounds 'u' and 'b'.

We have enjoyed our week of learning about pirates! In maths, we have been exploring capacity. We will continue with this next week! As part of our RE learning, we were introduced to a girl in a story and her family. We learnt that, just like some of us, she had a cat, cared for guinea pigs, enjoyed being outdoors and loved spending time with her family and friends. We were introduced to the cross and explored crosses around the school and had a go at making our own using a range of resources from around the classroom.
