This half term's learning: This half term we are learning all about Life in Kenya





The children will be learning where Kenya is, what the climate is like, what it is like to live there and how similar and different it is to the UK.

English

Firstly, we will be focusing on 'Meerkat Mail'. We will be rewriting our own innovated version.

We will then read 'The Stinky Cheese Man' where we will use our imagination to innovate a traditional tale.

In addition

Children will also be able to:

- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Use a variety of punctuation
- Use coordinating and subordinating conjunctions
- Use apostrophes for contraction and possession
- Use tense correctly and consistently

In phonics, children will continue to focus and recap all phonics sounds using RWI (Read Write, inc). Children will apply their phonics knowledge to their reading and spelling. In spelling, we will be learning new spelling rules.

The children will receive weekly Spellings and will be tested on these every Friday.

Every day the children will practice their number fluency through Number Nin jas followed by a short weekly arithmetic quiz on a

Our learning focus will be on:

- Time
- Statistics
- Position and direction
- Consolidation of the 4 operations

Please continue to work on your times tables using your TTRS log ins. This half term we are focusing on: 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s. Recapping these at home would really help consolidate children's knowledge.

Science

We be will learning about plants and their growth. We will use this knowledge to plant our own.

In RE we will continue to investigate the question "Why do people have different views about the ideas of God? (Christianity, Islam and Humanism)"

We will be investigating the structure of plant pots, designing and creating our own.

Computing

We will be continuing our Purple Mash scheme of work. We will be learning how to create music and presentations.

Music lessons will be provided by the Norfolk Music Hub and linked closely to our topic.

We will be exploring safety in different environments; risk; safety at home and emergencies. We will also be learning about and naming different parts of the human body.

We will be enjoying PE with Mrs Greenland and continuing Real PE with Miss King.

Our PE day will be Mondays and Tuesdays. Please make sure your child comes into school wearing their PE kit.
