English learning objectives: This half term we will begin by linking our writing to our new class novel, Floodland by Marcus Sedgwick We would encourage the children to have their own copy of the book, if possible, to support their reading in class. Reading Stars will continue each morning to develop the children's reading and comprehension skills. Maths learning objectives: This half terms focus will be on Fractions, Decimals and Percentages. As well as ensuring we are confident with our core calculations - boosting our Arithmetic scores.	Other curriculum areas : In Science we will be learning about Classification. We will learn about the system of classification, how we classify vertebrates, invertebrates, plants and Microorganisms. We will also learn about the habitats of these living things and the conservation of these. In Geography we will learn about Global Challenges. We will focus on how climate influences the way land is used, how we distribute the world's natural resources, how the world trades, how the challenge of sustainability affects the globe, how the challenge of climate change affects the globe and how the movement of borders and people affects the globe.
