Maths learning objectives:

This half term will start with completing our earlier work on investigating Ratios. The main focus will be on Geometry and the properties of shapes as well as

continuing to boost our Arithmetic confidence.

This half term's learning:

This half term's topic is all about Conflict and Resolution

This means our topic focus this half term will be **History**.





Other curriculum areas:

In Science we will continue learning about evolution. We will look at genetics and DNA, artificial selection and the threat of extinction.

In **History** we will learn about World War Two and life on the Home Front. We will learn about jobs, evacuees, Rationing and what life was like during the war.

Our **Art** this half term will link to our topic of conflict and resolution with the children creating propaganda posters

In RSHE we will be continuing to look at the impacts of the media on modern life and how it can influence people.

In RE we will be investigating the big question, What does it mean to be human?
