This half term's learning:
This half term we are learning all about
People Who Made a Difference

The children will be learning about individuals from the past and present who have made a difference.



The human rights heroes we will learn about are: Marcus Rashford, Nelson Mandela, Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King and Malala Yousafzai.



English

Firstly, we will be focusing on 'Amazing Grace'. We will read and review the book before using the text to create a diary entry. Then, we will be focusing on 'Guardians of the Planet' to write a persuasive report about protecting the environment. Finally, we will make further use of 'Guardians of the Planet' to write instructions for looking after our planet.



In addition:

Children will also be able to:

- Use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Use a variety of punctuation
- Use conjunctions
- Use apostrophes for contraction and possession
- Use suffixes

In **phonics**, children will continue to focus and recap all phonics sounds using RWI (Read Write, inc). Children will apply their phonics knowledge to their reading and spelling.

The children will receive weekly Spellings and will be tested on these every Friday.



Maths

Every day the children will practice their number fluency through Number Ninjas followed by a short weekly arithmetic quiz on a Friday.

Our learning focus will be on:

- Measurement: length & height, mass, capacity & temperature
- Recapping the 4 operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Fractions
- Answering problem solving and reasoning questions

Please continue to work on your times tables using your TTRS log ins. This half term we are focusing on: 2s, 3s, 4s, 5s and 10s. Recapping these at home would really help consolidate children's knowledge.

Science

We will be learning about protecting the environment. We will be applying this knowledge in our English writing.

RE

In RE we will investigate the question "Why do people have different views about the ideas of God? (Christianity, Islam and Humanism)"

Art

We will investigate the work of Esther Malangu and use her skills to create African prints.

Computing

We will be creating music media. We will explore rhythm, patterns, tempo and notes using our laptops.



Music

Music lessons will be provided by the Norfolk Music Hub and linked closely to our topic.

PSHE

We will be exploring what it means to be healthy, including: sleep, exercise, medicines, dental hygiene and mental health.

PE

We will be enjoying Real PE and cricket.
