This half term's topic is **Settlements and Land Use!**
This means our topic focus this half term will be...
Geography!



English

This half term we will begin by reading, 'Billy Goats Gruff' before exploring various other traditional tales. We will be using our creativity whilst learning how to write our own fairy tales and character descriptions. We will then move on to look at the story of, 'Stig of the Dump.'

We will get to know the characters and try to understand how they are feeling. We will finish by creating a newsletter and reading them out like a news reporter!

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at place value, representing numbers to 100! After this we will move onto partitioning numbers to 1000.

We will then revisit addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers focusing on being efficient and accurate as well as looking at some estimating. By the end of the half term, adding 2-digit numbers and 3-digit will be the main focus.

Geography

This half term we will be starting our new topic about fractured fairy tales. We will look at a range of tales as well as linking our geography to, 'Billy Goats Gruff', and exploring key physical features of our country such as mountains and hills.

Science

In Science we will be learning about Skeletons, Muscles and Nutrition. We will be finding out about how bones and muscles work as well as What a human skeleton looks like.

Design Technology

We will be exploring sculptures and practicing the interesting skill of creating our own sculptures.

Computing

We will begin by refreshing our knowledge on the important topics of E-safety and online safety. How can we stay safe?

Music

Music lessons will be provided by the Norfolk Music Hub - they always sound so fun!
